Detention Furniture Lever 23 Update

ASSA ABLOY Australia would like to announce an upgrade of the Lockwood Detention 23 lever in accordance with Australian Standard AS AS1428.1 Design for access and mobility. Part 1: General requirements for access - New building work.


Under this standard it is a requirement that the finger clearance on a lever or handle when used on the continuous accessible path is between 35mm and 45mm when measured from the centre of the grip section.

The continuous accessible path of travel is defined as an uninterrupted path of travel to, into or within a building providing access to all accessible facilities. To ensure that Lockwood Detention Furniture may be used in these applications the lever 23 has undergone a subtle change and now complies with this requirement.

This change is effective immediately on all part numbers that feature the 23 lever.
